

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Senior Airman Lance A. Weston distinguished himself by meritorious service as Aviation Resource Management Systems Developer, 554th Electronic Systems Group, 554th Electronic Systems Wing, Maxwell Air Force Base-Gunter Annex, Alabama. During this period, Airman Weston brilliantly crafted software for the 30 million dollar Aviation Resource Management System expertly resolving 146 complex discrepancies improving Aviation Resources Management Systems Developers 6.0 system for 67,000 aviators. He adroitly rewrote 1,020 lines of code revolutionizing the way Aviation Resources Management System Developers handle flyer status codes to provide streamlined and error-free functionality. Airman Weston's programming prowess was exemplified when he pinpointed 16 major system flaws and identified their global system effect saving over 100 man-hours in recoding efforts. Additionally, he performed exceptionally in 80 details and in eight different roles as a base Honor Guard member delivering proper respect and remembrance to local veterans and fallen heroes. The distinctive accomplishments of Airman Weston, while serving his country, reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
